Why have the SDGs gotten to be so popular in Japan? What about in other countries? There is actually an unknown history and background behind this current situation. What should Japanese business people do with the SDGs and integrate them into their management practices? The "Outside-In Business Approach" is an official term by the United Nations and should be the second stage of how business integrate the SDGs into their operations.
